

Sharecropping: Post War Slavery

The Victor's Exploitation of Dixie

“Trust in God and Leave Us Alone,” was the motto emblazoned on the flag of the 6th La. Inf. This was the attitude of the white South post-Appomattox. Historian H.K. Beale noted that most whites “wanted nothing from politicians but a chance to live their lives undisturbed.” But as Andrew Nelson Lytle lamented “The mercies of God did not bring independence. Nor was the War over. One phase was done...the avowed purpose was the destruction of Southern Civilization.” Following their glorious victory the Republican Party in Washington initiated a campaign to assure the Republican Party would control Lincoln’s newly created Federal Empire. Black and white Southerners would play a key role in this Republican effort. In the process the Republican Party would establish a new and more deadly form of slavery—tenant farming, aka sharecropping.

The Republican Party foisted upon the conquered and occupied South a system of peonage that would chain over 8 million Southerners to a system of grueling debt and poverty. Census records demonstrate that 60% of these were white. Northern invasion and exploitation created an environment that assured permanent Northern control of the Federal Empire & provided windfall economic profits for Northern financial & commercial interests. Meanwhile the South became America’s political & economic backwater; an impoverished embarrassment; the proverbial red headed step child at America’s family reunion. The sad reality is that the War did *not* end slavery—it merely changed it into an even more destructive form of servitude.

The vast majority of pre-War white Southerners were not a part of the plantation system. Most were not even heavily engaged in farming. These were the “Plain Folk” of the old South whose primary economic enterprise was as herdsmen with large herds of cattle and hogs roaming the South’s open range. They had a healthy life style that stressed outdoor activities such as hunting

and fishing. Their herds provided food and the little cash they needed. Low intensity farming provided vegetables. Corn provided bread, cattle feed, or the makings of liquid refreshment. They enjoyed a healthy and relatively care-free life style. They were often incorrectly referred to by Northern writers as “poor white trash.” They were rugged individualists who had little need for local government and even less for one in far-away Washington. Their main demand of government was simply to leave them alone! Thus when the Federal Empire marched its armies into the South these “Plain Folk” rallied to the defense of their Southern homeland.

The War destroyed much of the South’s livestock and post-War Reconstruction legislatures enacted enclosure laws which closed off much of the South’s open range. The population was reduced to poor whites and even poorer blacks. In order to make a crop, black & white farmers had to borrow money and hope they made enough on their crops to repay the debt and take their families through the winter months. This bondage to debt was unheard of prior to Appomattox. As a result of the War, cash (capital) in the South was almost nonexistent. This was not an issue before Yankee conquest! Southern banking capital in 1860 = \$61M—in 1870 = \$17M. The Republican Party passed taxes on Southern cotton that cost defenseless Southerners \$68M in 1868. Due to the lack of capital Southern industries could not develop but this was a windfall to the North because over \$80M was spent purchasing ag implements from Northern sources. The credit cost to sharecroppers has been estimated to have been between 50 to 125% annually. Poverty, malnutrition, disease and high infant mortality were epidemic across the South. In 1860 the average plantation had five slave families working the plantation—in 1930 large landowners had on average five white or black sharecropper families working the plantation.

Modern day politicians, historians, and media moguls refused to acknowledge the simple fact that none of this suffering would have occurred had the Northern majority allowed the Southern people to peacefully establish a country of their own—if the Federal Empire had simply honored God and left us alone.

The Death of Free Speech

What does two Islamic terrorists attempting to kill Texans who were drawing cartoons of Mohammed and the politically correct (p.c.) attacks upon Southern Rights have in common? The agents of political correctness, like their Islamic terrorist counterpart, believe they alone have the right to sit in judgment on the speech and actions of all unbelievers, i.e., those who do not hold to the p.c. view of the world. The actions of the p.c. terrorists can be just as violent and deadly as that of the Islamic terrorists.

When people express doubts about this statement, I challenge them to read, *Death by Journalism?* This book details the effort of a good Christian man who only sought to enlighten young people about the truth of the War for Southern Independence. Jack Perdue, a regional historian of the Greensboro, North Carolina area, was asked to teach a “Southern History” course at Randolph Community College. 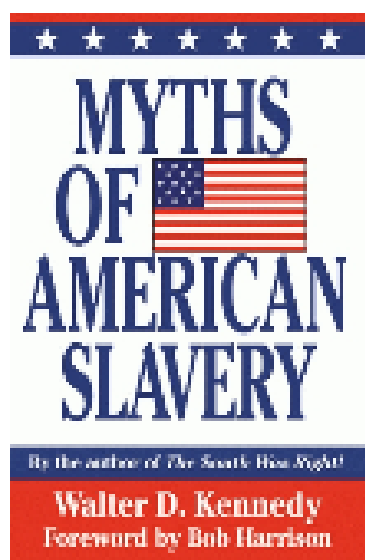

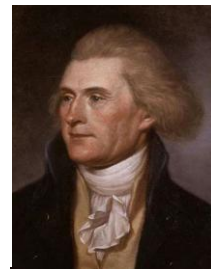

What is Vision 2020?

A. No! The purpose of the SCV is to work for the vindication of the Cause for which our ancestors fought. It is and should remain non-political but that does not mean that we should refrain from seeking political solutions as private citizens outside of the SCV.

Q. Are you advocating secession?

A. No. Secession and nullification are constitutional rights that the sovereign states reserved when they created the Federal government under the original constitution. They were meant to be tools to be used by “we the people” of the sovereign states to protect liberty—to be the final check on attempts by the Federal government to infringe on our rights, liberty and property. The most important thing about the American principles of secession and nullification are that they are typically not needed as long as the central government recognizes them as constitutional rights. Federal government.

Q. We are too few, how could we accomplish this?

A. Remember Gideon in the Old Testament—numbers are not as important as determination and faith of a few! As explained in “Let’s Take Our Country Back!” we do not need to win an election to win for our Cause. Yes it will take two or three thousand dedicated Southerners but together we can win our freedom—we can restore constitutional government in America. 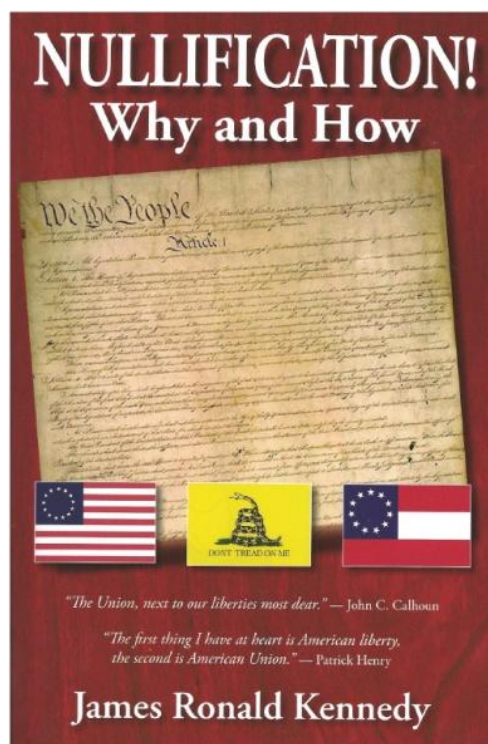

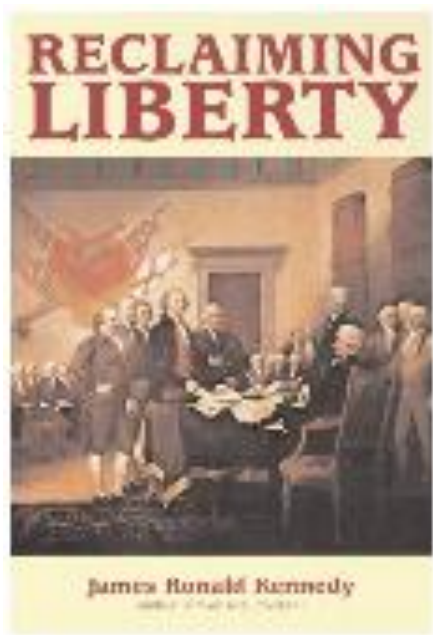

Reconstruction: How the Federal Empire Created a Climate of Racial Hatred
